## Post-Graduate Year 1 Residency Program

The PGY1 Residency Program at **CHRISTUS Mother Frances Hospital - Tyler** is a one-year training program designed to enhance and strengthen the resident's clinical skills and knowledge of the practice of pharmacy. A high priority is placed on teaching evidence-based care and preparing residents for the variety of opportunities available to PGY1 graduates.

- All application material submitted through PhORCAS
- Doctor of Pharmacy degree from an ACPE accredited school of pharmacy
- Eligible for licensure with the Texas State Board of Pharmacy
  - All licensing tests must be attempted no later than June 19, 2025
- Official college(s) of pharmacy transcript(s)
- Letter of intent
- Curriculum vitae
  - Include completed and anticipated advanced pharmacy practice experiences
- Three letters of recommendation
  - Direct patient care APPE preceptors recommended
- GPA  $\geq 3.0$
- Selected applicants will be interviewed
